Perfect result for RDM-Cargraphic-Logwin-Racing Rank 14 of 197 vehicles during the legendary 24h Nürburgring race

RDM-Cargraphic-Logwin-Racing had already achieved excellent results during the 2009 24h race at the Nürburgring. Just in time for the 25th anniversary of vehicle tuner **Cargraphic**, the race team, which has been working together under Kurt Ecke for many years, achieved its best result yet with the powerful 1200 kilogram, 410 PS / 302 kW Porsche 997 CUP. After exactly 24 hours, 6 minutes and 50,206 seconds, he crossed the finish line in 14th place among 197 starters. In spite of the fact that the participation of factory teams and semi-factory teams was higher than average in 2010, the team was able to gain two ranks compared to last year. Within the SP 9 class, the 145 rounds, at an average speed of 152.601 km/h covered by the racers, who started under the FIA GT3 specification, even amounted to 8th place. Besides **Cargraphic**, sponsors included the logistics company **Logwin**, **Unity Media** and the firm, **Tabler High Tech Blech**.

"Together with Kurt Ecke, we wanted to focus our company's commitment on one major event this year", Michael Schnarr, managing director of **Cargraphic**, said. "And it paid off." For years, **Cargraphic** has been successfully subjecting its products, which are mainly manufactured in-house, to veritable trips through "hell", particularly its stainless steel exhaust systems and light-alloy wheels. Once again, the high-quality components showed no signs of weakness on the 25,378 kilometres of the world's toughest race track. The experienced trio of drivers, consisting of team leader Kurt Ecke, Peter König und Steffen Schlichenmeier, also displayed their superiority: the threesome covered the fastest round at an average of 163.804 km/h. The only downside: due to the intensive preparations required for the 24h race, **Cargraphic** did not have time to send its own vehicle to participate in the Tuner GP at the Hockenheimring, which took place only one week later.
